United Firefighters' Union of Australia, Union of Employees, Queensland is a union with members employed in the Queensland Public Sector.

The kinds of information of union may collect.

You may supply personal information to the union by, for example, filling in a meeting attendance sheet, completing a membership form, discussing your issues with a delegate, industrial officer or signing up to a campaign. The union only collects personal information that is necessary for the union to perform its functions and/or activities.

Disclosure of your personal information

The union may disclose your personal information, in connection with, or to further the purposes outlined in the policy to;

- QCU (based in Queensland)

By providing your personal information to the union, you consent to us transferring your personal information to other such organisations for the purposes listed in the policy.

How you may seek to access and/or correct personal information held by the union
