## The Queen Jubilee Holiday and Queens Birthday Payments

## 'Continuous Shift Workers'

The public holiday penalties for the one-off Queens's Diamond Jubilee on Monday, 11 June 2012 are as follows:

- Officers who work this public holiday are to be paid double time and a half, i.e. a normal day's pay plus time and a half for all hours worked;
- Those officers rostered off, on annual leave, or long service leave are to be paid their normal rate of pay plus an additional eight hours.
- Any officer who is on sick leave on the public holiday is to be paid their normal rate of pay.

The Public holiday penalties for the Queens's Birthday holiday on Monday, 1 October 2012 are as follows:

- Officers who work this public holiday are to be paid time and a half, i.e. a normal day's pay plus a half, for all hours worked;
- Those officers on annual leave are to be paid time and a half, i.e. a normal days pay plus a half, for hours they would have normally been rostered to work on the public holiday.
- Those officers rostered off, on long service leave or sick leave are to be paid their normal rate of pay.

### 'Day Workers

All other officers who do not work on the following days are to receive their normal rate of pay:

- Monday, 11 June 2012 (the one off, Queens Diamond Jubilee);
- Monday, 1 October 2012 (Queens Birthday).

# **Exemption from Election**

Positions has now been granted by the ECQ. This is because the Federal positions fill the State positions in the Union. This is the same as previous years and I have attached the notice of exemption to this "Code 2" for your viewing.

Re: Application for exemption from holding an election [Matter no. RIO/2012/45]

I refer to an application filed in the Industrial Registry on 14 May 2012 by United Firefighters' Union of Australia, Union of Employees, Queensland [UFU] for exemption under section 580 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999* from holding an election for stated offices.

It is noted that no objections to the application have been lodged in the Registry.

UFU is an employee organisation registered under the *Industrial Relations Act 1999*. United Firefighters' Union of Australia is an employee organisation registered under the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 [C'Wealth]. I have perused the affidavit of Mr John Oliver and the rules of each of the organisations and am satisfied that the Queensland branch of the United Firefighters' Union of Australia is a counterpart federal body of UFU within the meaning of s. 411 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999*.

Being satisfied as required by section 580(2) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999*, on 14 May 2012 I granted UFU exemption from holding an election for the following stated offices, in accordance with the Australian Electoral Commission election result [E2011/E 2707] declared on 10 May 2012.

The officers are to take up office in accordance with the rules of United Firefighters' Union of Australia, Union of Employees, Queensland.

It is noted that the following two (2) offices were not filled as a result of this election process -

State Firefighters Delegate (North Coast Region) State Firefighters Delegate (South West Region)

As these offices were not filled by election, no exemption can be granted from conducting a state election for these offices. In the event of a further election being conducted for these offices, and the Australian Electoral Commission issuing a Declaration of Results, consideration will then be given to granting an exemption from holding an election for these offices.
